RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All applications, a copy of your insurance coverage and the Windsor Essex County Health Unit Forms should be returned by June 1, 2019 with a cheque for **\$340 (HST included)** payable to the Belle River-On the Lake BIA
- Anyone using fuel fired mobile appliance (propane or natural gas) in the form of a trailer / truck etc needs to consult a fuel safety inspector from TSSA to ensure the set up of their equipment meets their requirements
- You must meet all Board of Health Requirements! Please read their flyer and **complete the application** which must be returned with your contract
- You must be open and prepared to do business at the opening time of the festival
- Removal or take down of booths before closing is not permitted.
- Thursday morning set up is between 10 am and 2 pm. Please check in with security. Vendor locates will be installed on Wednesday and requests for early set up may be considered.
- You are responsible for your own water hoses and extension cords.
- The Belle River-On the Lake BIA reserves the right to not accept any applications. **No** refunds on any cancellations.
- Locations will be assigned as your applications are accepted. Vendor acceptance package will be available before the event (contains a parking pass, a site map, and a complete vendor list)

********Remember that a clean, attractive and well planned booth will increase your sales. A shady eating area will be provided close to the food area. Use your space creatively. If your booth is clean, interesting and appealing - people will stop and look...buying is the next step.***

Zero Waste: Food / Catering Services

Belle River-On the Lake is adopting a Sunsplash Zero Waste Goal and represents a different approach which will tackle waste in our local environment.

The purpose of this goal is to promote, facilitate and model Zero Waste strategies in our local area and at special events.

- SUPPLIERS SHALL RECYCLE AND/OR COMPOST MATERIALS THAT ARE RECYCLABLE AND BIODEGRADABLE
- NO POLYSTYRENE(STYROFOAM) / PLASTIC PRODUCTS FOR FOOD OR BEVERAGES ARE TO BE USED - PAPER BASED PRODUCTS PREFERRED
- SUPPLIERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO OFFER PRICE INCENTIVES FOR RE-USABLE MUGS OR CUPS
- CELLOPHANE TO WRAP PREPARED FOOD IS TO BE AVOIDED- USE WAX OR BUTCHER PAPER
- NAPKIN DISPENSERS ARE PREFERRED TO ELIMINATE WASTE
- WATER PITCHERS/REFILLS INSTEAD OF SINGLE SERVE PLASTIC BOTTLES ARE PREFERRED
- SUPPLIERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO DONATE SURPLUS FOOD TO LOCAL SHELTERS AND FOOD BANKS.
- ZERO WASTE AND RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS SHALL BE VISIBLE IN THE FOOD COURT AND PREPARATION AREAS

Recyclable and Biodegradable options:

- Paper based plates/cups/bowls with plastic dome lids
- Wooden stir sticks as opposed to plastic stir sticks
- Paper coffee cups with no lids
- Metal food containers and beverage cans
- All paper products are preferred because recyclable
- Biodegradable cutlery and straws
- Aluminum foil, trays, plates, cans and containers
- Recycled unbleached compostable napkins are preferred
- Milk or Juice cartons that are recyclable
